1. **Artist Gardens of Europe** - 42 minutes Tour the gardens that inspired Monet, Renoir, Rubens and Rodin in France and Belgium, interviews with the caretakers
2. **Bartram** - 30 Minutes – Bartram's travels in Florida
3. **Book of Evidence Made Simple** - 40 minutes, Excellent description of how to assemble a BOE to apply for awards. Procedure is dated, but content remains accurate.
4. **Chelsea Flower Show** 1998 – Official Souvenir Video - 60 Minutes – from set-up to the winners, Capture Chelsea's floral colour on a grand scale
5. **Chelsea. Memories of** – 60 Minutes – 200 year history of the Chelsea Flower Show. Plants, gardens, the Royal Family visits.

9. **ECHO** - World Gardening – Feed the world's hungry by teaching them to grow food. 9 minutes introduction, 17 minutes overview of the program throughout the world. Test gardens, drought resistant plants
10. **Florida Park Service** - 12 minutes, Overview of our state park system
11. **Galapagos Archipelago. Protecting the: Paradise Found** - 10 minutes
12. **Gardens of Australia** - 45 minutes – Gorgeous: Tropical rain forest, classic English Gardens, urban and rural.
13. **Gardens of the Netherlands** - 45 minutes, Three gardens including one that is 400 years old, where tulips were first introduced and the World Famous Keukenhof Gardens, 'English country' garden style
14. **Gardens of the World** - Narrated by Audrey Hepburn - 50 minutes - Tour world famous formal gardens
15. **Good People Doing Good Things** – 16 Minutes – How individuals can make a difference in water conservation
16. **Herbs** – 36 min, Crafts and Herb Culture and usage. Potpourri. How to make herb wreaths. Herb Identification.
17. **Herbs and Crafts. Growing Connection in Therapy** - 30 Minutes - Atlanta Botanical Garden - Garden Therapy for Disabled, Adaptive gardens, Horticulture Therapy
18. **Holiday Happenings**, Bob Thomas - 30 Minute, Holiday Design Program
19. **Hydroponic Garden. How to Build a Floating Garden** – 20 Minutes – Includes handout – How to construct a soil-free plant growing system with ordinary building materials.
20. **It's A Miracle** – Inspirational Miracle of the Life of a Butterfly – Tristan's Butterfly Garden, planted as a memorial by a DeLand middle school Special Education Class. 20 Minutes

23. **Ocklawaha. Restoring the Florida Defenders of the Environment** - - 22 mins 1990
24. **Planting the Bones of the Garden: Landscape Basics**, by Penelope Hobhouse - 20 Minutes, With Longwood Gardens and other English gardens used as examples, she explains the structural elements that form the bones of a garden – where to begin planning a landscape, defined by it's framing plants.
