- Cannas, Alligator Flag:** Brazilian Skipper
- Cassias/Sennas, Partridge Pea:** Cloudless Sulphur, Little Yellow, Orange-Barred Sulphur, Sleepy Orange
- Citrus, Torchwood, Wild Lime:** Giant Swallowtail
- Coontie:** Atala Hairstreak
- Elms:** Comma, Mourning Cloak
- Fogfruit/Frogfruit (*Phyla nodiflora*):** Phaon Crescent, White Peacock
- Hackberry Tree:** Hackberry Emperor, Mourning Cloak, Question Mark, Snout, Tawny Emperor
- Hoptree:** Giant Swallowtail, Eastern Tiger Swallowtail
- Jamaica Dogwood:** Hammock Skipper
- Milkweeds (*Asclepias*):** Monarch, Queen
- Parsley (Italian self-sows), Dill, Fennel:** Eastern Black Swallowtail
- Passionflower Vine:** Gulf & Variegated Fritillary, Julia, Zebra Heliconian
- Pawpaw:** Zebra Swallowtail
- Pellitory (*Purietaria floridana*), False Nettle (*Boehmeria*), Hop Vine (*Humulus*):** Comma, Red Admiral
- Pipevine (*Aristolochia*):** Pipevine Swallowtail, Polydamas Swallowtail
- Plumbago (there is a native one):** Cassius Blue
- Red Bay, Sweet Bay Magnolia:** Palamedes Swallowtail, Spicebush Swallowtail
- Rue:** Giant Swallowtail, Black Swallowtail
- Ruellia, Snapdragon, Verbena:** Buckeye, American Lady, White Peacock
- Sassafrass, Spicebush:** Spicebush Swallowtail
- Strangler Fig:** Ruddy Daggerwing
- Violets (Native):** Variegated Fritillary
- Willows (Native):** Viceroy, Mourning Cloak, Red-Spotted Purple
