

Directions to Wakulla Springs State Park

550 Wakulla Park Drive, Crawfordville, FL 32327

Locations East of Tallahassee

- Take I-10 west towards Tallahassee
- Exit at SR 59, turn left to head south towards Lloyd and Wacissa, This exit is about 10 miles BEFORE the first Tallahassee exit and is after the US 19 exit
- Pass over US 27 and head into the community of Wacissa
- Continue straight pass the flashing lights in Wacissa and veer right to stay on SR 59
- Follow SR 59 south to where it ends at US 98
- Turn right on US 98, heading west, and follow to Newport
- Pass St. Marks Wildlife Refuge and cross over the St. Marks River. Just past Newport, turn right on SR 267
- Cross over the flashing lights at Woodville Hwy and continue on SR 267 to the State Park entrance on your left (If you pass the flashing lights at Wakulla Springs Road you have gone too far)
- Follow the road into the State Park and follow the sign to the Lodge
- Registration will be inside the main doors of the Lodge

Locations West of Tallahassee

- Take I-10 east towards Quincy
- Pass the SR 12 exit and take the next exit – SR 267 and head south
- Follow SR 267 to where it ends at SR 20 and take a left to head east
- Cross over the Ochlockonee River and veer right on SR 267
- Follow SR 267 southeast through the Apalachicola National Forest and pass through the stop light at the intersection of US 319/Crawfordville Hwy
- Just past the flashing lights at Wakulla Springs Road, turn right at the State Park entrance
- Follow the road into the State Park and follow the sign to the Lodge
- Registration will be inside the main doors of the Lodge

Coming from US 98 South

- On the north side of the town of Perry, turn left at the stoplight to stay on US 98 heading west towards Newport
- Pass St. Marks Wildlife Refuge and cross over the St. Marks River. Just past Newport, turn right on SR 267
- Cross over the flashing lights at Woodville Hwy and continue on SR 267 to the State Park entrance on your left (If you pass the flashing lights at Wakulla Springs Road you have gone too far)
- Enter the Park and follow the sign to the Lodge
- Registration will be inside the main doors of the Lodge
