CLOTHING

Rain gear
Underwear
Jeans/pants
Shirts (t-shirts/blouses)
Socks

Functional)

LINENS & BEDDING

2 single sheets
Pillow & pillowcase
Bath towel, wash cloth
Laundry bag
Blanket & mattress pad

PERSONAL ITEMS

Soap and soap dish
Toothbrush and toothpaste
Comb, brush & toilet articles
Deodorant (non-aerosol)
Flashlight/batteries
Sunscreen
Handkerchiefs/tissues
Alarm clock
Coffee Cup & unbreakable glass
Beach Towel
Water/sipper bottle
Insect Repellent (non-aerosol)

HELPFUL ITEMS

Camera, film
Pencil, pen, notebook
Compass & binoculars
Night Light/Reading Lamp
Bath mat/throw rug
Fan

NOT ALLOWED: Camp policies do not permit alcohol, guns, knives, and any item in an aerosol can.

DRESS CODE: Volunteers have a right to wear clothing of their choice as long as appropriate for Camp. Sandals and flip-flops are not allowed. Shirts and T-shirts with message must be in good taste. Volunteers **MUST WEAR CLOSED-TOED SHOES AND SOCKS.**

STAFF SHIRTS and **WYC T-Shirts** will be available for sale.

FEEL FREE TO BRING a favorite pillow, folding chair, folding clothes dryer, etc. Also bring a coffee pot if you'd like coffee in your cabin. (Don't forget a mug as all kitchen items are inventoried and must stay in the kitchen. The Camp is charged for missing items.) Leader cabins do have refrigerators, as well as bathrooms.
