

THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT REGISTRATION

**Please read carefully all material relating to your application for a campership.
The Registration Packet includes the following:**

1. Registration Form - please send a wallet-sized photograph of your child
2. Health Form, 4 pages of Form 1 and 1 page of Form 2, **must be filled out each year** and **signed by physician.**
3. Camper's Agreement Form, camper must read and must be signed by parent and camper
4. Copy of Insurance Card (Front and Back).
5. Check for Registration Processing Fee
6. Check for Camper's Fee
7. Activity Fee Check

May be paid in one check

REGISTRATION MATERIALS MUST BE SUBMITTED TO REGISTRAR Prior to Camp, you will receive confirmation with your child's assigned dates for camp. Make sure each item your child brings to camp has his/her name written indelibly on it. It will be the responsibility of your child to keep track of and take care of, his/her belongings. Do not bring expensive watches, jewelry or other valuable items. Camp policy does not permit: Cell Phones, Beepers, CD Players, iPods, Radios, Electronic or Video Games, Chewing Gum, Food, Knives, or items in aerosol cans. Registration is limited to 104 campers in each weekly session. Dates for the **2010** Camp Session are printed on the Registration Form. To hold a space for a camper, all camp fees for the desired week **MUST** accompany registration packet. To avoid disappointment, reserve desired date early. The Registrar will work to make re-assignments should your plans should your plans change, space permitting and with as much advance notice as possible. Read carefully the instructions for Check In/Registration Day and for Check Out.

Boys and girls who have completed grades 3-8 by the end of the current school year (2009-2010) are eligible to attend camp.

After May 1, 2010 priority will be given based on order of receipt and availability.
