Register your Garden Club - Every Youth Garden Club needs to be: Sponsored by an FFGC Garden Club Need to register each year - Registration forms are on ffgc.org under forms Have a minimum # of members and meet a certain # of times

Differences in Youth Gardeners:

Junior Gardeners - Pre-k to 5th Grade or elementary school-aged 5 members who meet a minimum of 5 times. Intermediate - 6th - 8th Grades- Middle Schoolers High - 9th -12th Grades - High Schoolers
