

Location, Parking & Directions:

Location: Orlando Garden Club (OGC) is located at 710 East Rollins St in Loch Haven Park Orlando between the Orlando Science Center and The Florida Hospital.

Parking: Entrance to the adjacent parking lot is on Camden St.

From Winter Park: Orange Ave and Mills Ave Intersection (US-17, US -92, US-17/92). Drive South .8m on Mills Ave. Turn right at the traffic light on to E. Rollins St. The Orlando Garden Club is .3 mile on the left. **Camden St** is the next left past the building.

From I4 North: Take exit ramp 85
Turn left onto Princeton St. Drive .2m. Turn left on to Bedford Rd & drive to the end. Turn right onto East Rollins St. Take the next right onto **Camden St.** Parking is on the left.

From I4 North: Take exit ramp 86
Turn right onto Princeton St. Drive .2m. Turn left on to Bedford Rd & drive to the end. Turn right onto East Rollins St. Take the next right onto **Camden St.** Parking is on the left.

Learn the Art of Floral Design

Basic Floral Design Study is a six-unit series with the goal of developing an understanding of the art of flower arranging for both the home and flower shows.

These Floral Design units are taught by National Garden Club Master Judges and FFGC Floral Design Instructors. All instructors are recognized for their extensive knowledge and experience in floral design. They have competed in flower shows and present workshops and programs throughout Florida and other states. Their designs regularly appear in The Creative Floral Arrangers of The Americas (CFAA) *Design Dimensions* magazine as well as the FFGC and NGC Calendars.

Our instructors create friendly and engaging environment to learn floral design. Each unit consists of a lecture and demonstration during the morning. The instructor will create floral designs as she explains the required materials and techniques. After lunch students create their own designs, receive feedback from their instructor, and share their designs with new friends.

- ❖ Students must bring SCISSORS/CLIPPERS and LUNCH.
- ❖ Morning snacks, Coffee, Ice Tea, and water will be provided.
- ❖ Students will receive a kit containing pin holder, container & other design aids at the first class
- ❖ Line materials, foliage and flowers are supplied for the first three classes.
- ❖ Students are encouraged to make up missed units from previous classes or repeat the series as many times as they wish.
- ❖ Students completing all 6 floral design units will receive a certificate of completion from FFGC and will be eligible to enroll in the advanced Floral Design Units, 7, 8, 9 lectures and workshops.
